Please note, P.E. schedules may change due to swimming etc. Where this is the case, we will provide you with details in advance if this impacts on your child's class.



EARRINGS/STUDS

No jewellery is allowed in school. This includes earrings and studs (as well as plastic/ clear studs). We understand that some children may have their ears pierced during the school holidays. However, as we approach October we would now expect that any earrings/studs can be safely removed. Please note that plasters will not be allowed to cover earrings/studs. No tattoos, nail varnish or make-up are to be worn in school.

We ask all parents and carers to support us in ensuring our children understand the importance of school uniform and being a member of the team.
