Dear Parents/Carers,

HALLOWEEN AND BONFIRE NIGHT

An important message from Merseyside Police has been sent out on our Social Media sites and School Spider App. Please take the time to read this important advice.

To summarise -

We want everyone to have fun and we'll be working hard to keep you safe, but we need your help: Know where your children are, know the risks and know the law.

- ◆ **If your children are going out (particularly on the 30th and 31st of October), make sure you know where they're going. If possible, drop them off and pick them up**
- ◆ **Don't buy fireworks or eggs and flour for them, and don't let them take it out of the house**
- ◆ **Messing around with fireworks is dangerous – some burn as hot as 1,200 degrees - hot enough to melt glass and cause serious or fatal injuries**
- ◆ **A person under the age of 16 can be arrested and fined if found with an unlit firework**
- ◆ **A person under the age of 16 can be arrested and fined for throwing things like eggs, flour, paint or other objects at people, vehicles or property**

Thank you for your help and support. By working together, we can keep your children safe this Halloween and Bonfire Night. Merseyside Police.

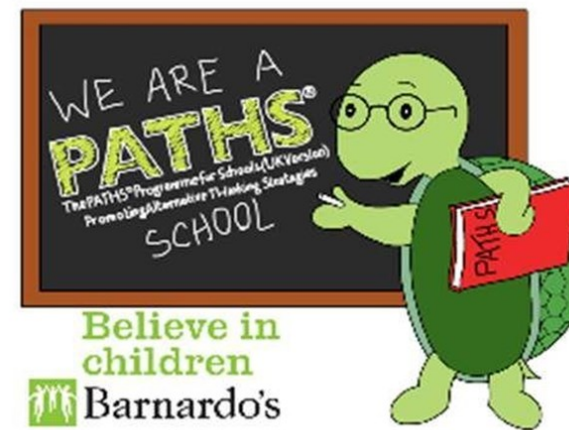
They started their new duties this week and have already been a great source of support and fun for #teamcarmill. Well done children!
