### Tickets for Christmas Plays

The dates for the Christmas parties for each phase are in the table of dates above. In order to provide the children with drinks, treats and prizes at the party we will be asking parents to pay £1 per ticket for all the Christmas Concerts. Tickets for the plays will be given on a first come, first served based and are restricted to 2 per family. They will go on sale on School Money from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> November up to the 6<sup>th</sup> December. After this date, any remaining tickets will be made available for all- they will be on sale from the evening of Monday 9<sup>th</sup> December. Please note that tickets can only be purchased via school money. If you do not have school money you can come into the school office and pay via card. Due to restrictions with how many can fit in the church, we only have so many tickets available. We cannot admit anyone without a ticket.
