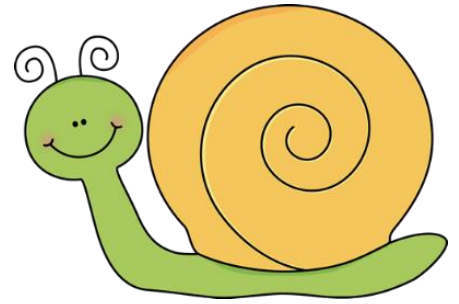


Week Ending 24th May
